Community Champions



Thank you for your interest in the Community Champions Program.

This program is run by The WA Digital Inclusion Project. To become a Champion, you must meet the selection criteria. This helps us to ensure that you benefit from the program and that we can support you.

Selection Criteria

To become a Champion, you must:

- ✓ Be 18 years or older,
- Be willing to commit to participating in the program. This includes attending training, and organising and delivering digital information sessions.
- Be able to reach at least 10 people in your network who are or have been digitally excluded,
- Be able to present a session to people you know (after training),
- Have some lived experience of digital exclusion,
- Be willing to complete a participant agreement,
- Be willing to share experiences, for example, through completing surveys or an interview.
- Be confident in using a digital device at a basic level (for example - playing a video, presenting a PowerPoint, and sending an email).

Application and Selection Process

Expressions of interest will be open until the program has completed. The estimated program completion date is March 2025.

You will have an interview, either in person or online. At the interview, we will verify your confidence and digital skills.

After you are interviewed, we will let you know if you were successful by email.

To begin, you must agree to become a Champion and sign a Participant Agreement. Once you have signed up to be a Champion, you will be invited to attend the next suitable training session.
