

# Community Champions



Thank you for your interest in the Community Champions Program. This program is run by the WA Digital Inclusion Project.

To become a Community Champion, you must meet the selection criteria. This helps us to ensure that you benefit from the program and that we can support you.

## Selection Criteria

To become a Champion, you must:

- ✓ Be 18 years or older,
- ✓ Be willing to commit to participate in the program. This includes attending training, and organising and delivering digital information sessions,
- ✓ Be able to reach at least 10 people per session who could be your family, friends or communities that you are already involved in,
- ✓ Be able to present a session to people you know (after training), which includes leading a conversation on a specific topic,
- ✓ Have some lived experience of digital exclusion,
- ✓ Be willing to complete a Participant Agreement,
- ✓ Be willing to share experiences, for example, through completing surveys or an interview,
- ✓ Be confident to use a digital device at a basic level (for example, playing a video, presenting a PowerPoint and sending an email)
- ✓ Have a passion for sharing useful information with their friends, family and communities.

## Expressing your interest to be a Community Champion

Expressions of interest will be open until the program is complete.

We will have a conversation with you to discuss your passion for supporting your friends, family and communities, and check your confidence and skills to use a laptop at a basic level (i.e. turn it on, play a video, show a website, present a PowerPoint, send an email).

If you meet the selection criteria and there are spaces available, you will be invited to attend a training session.
